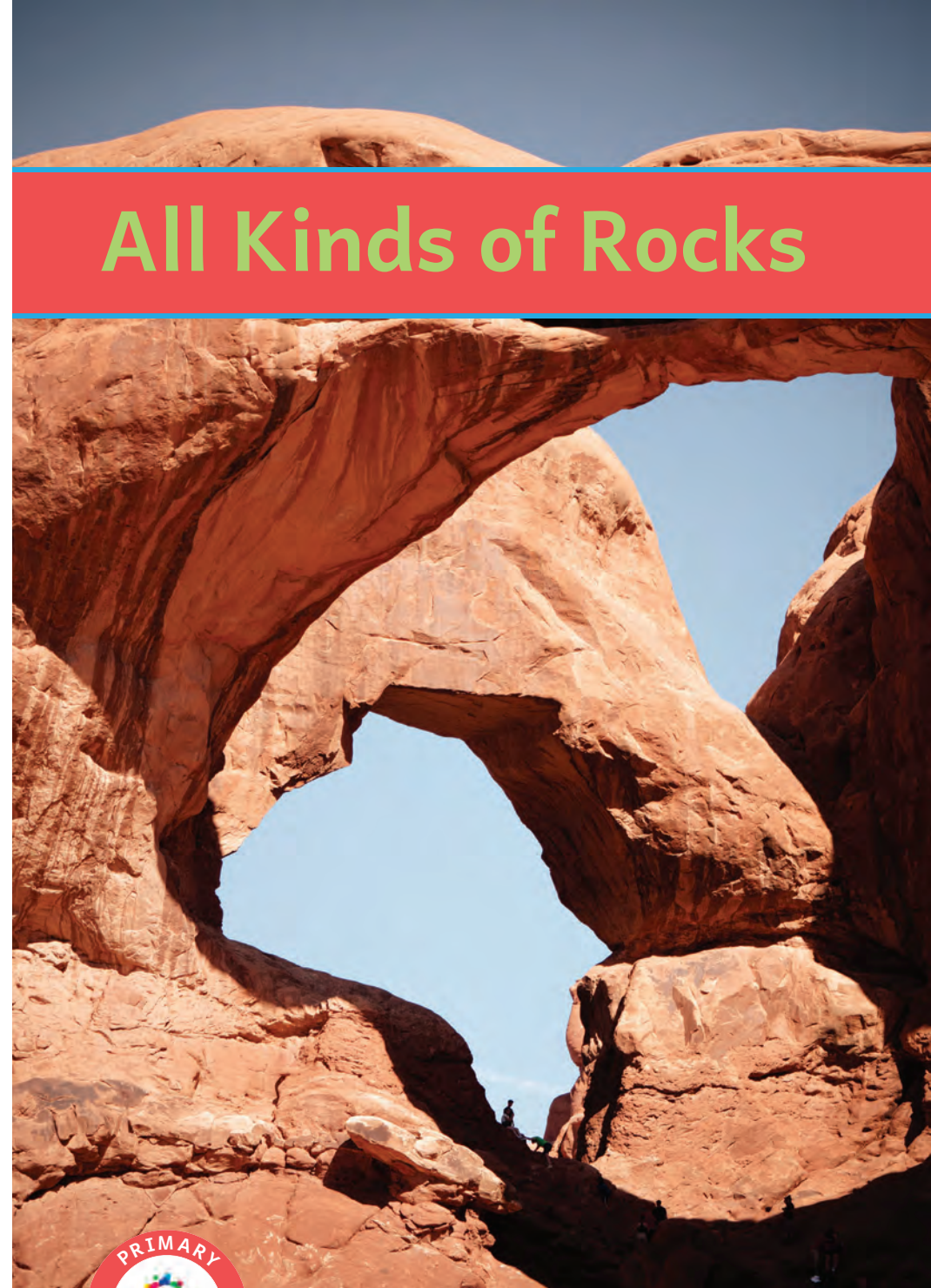

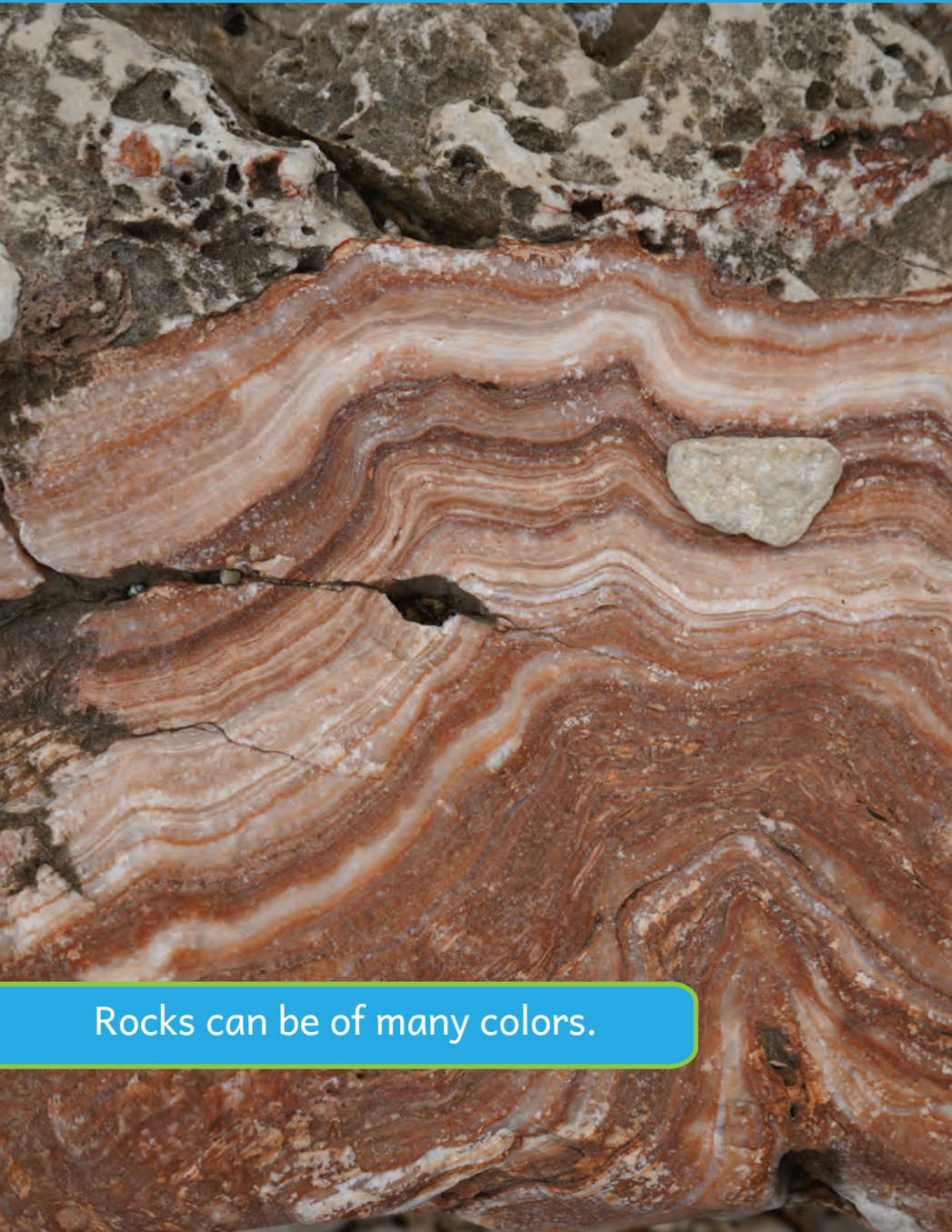
A park is a good spot to see rocks.
