This game is quidditch. It was made-up in a book. Now you can play it in real life.

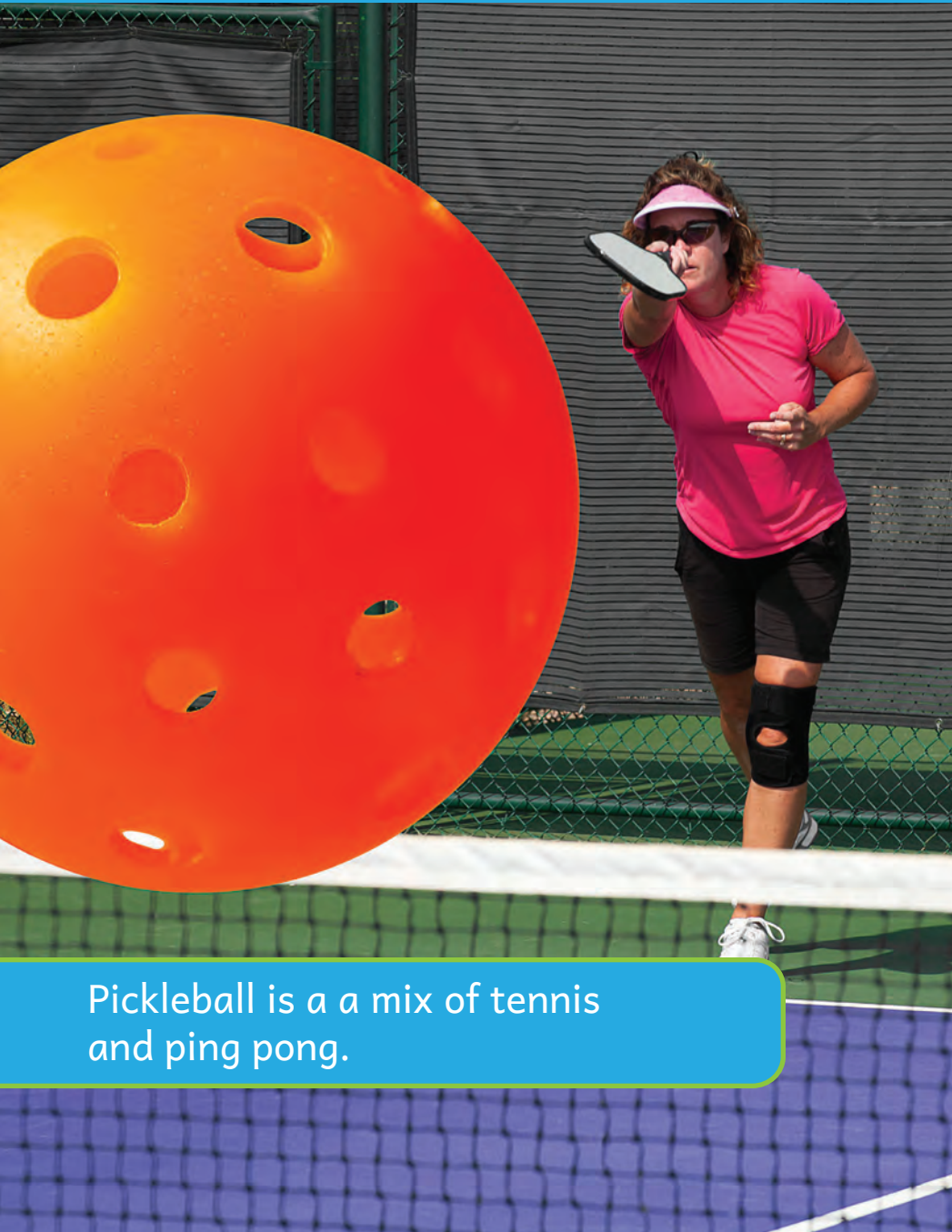
Sport balls can have odd names.
