Sheets can make a good tent.

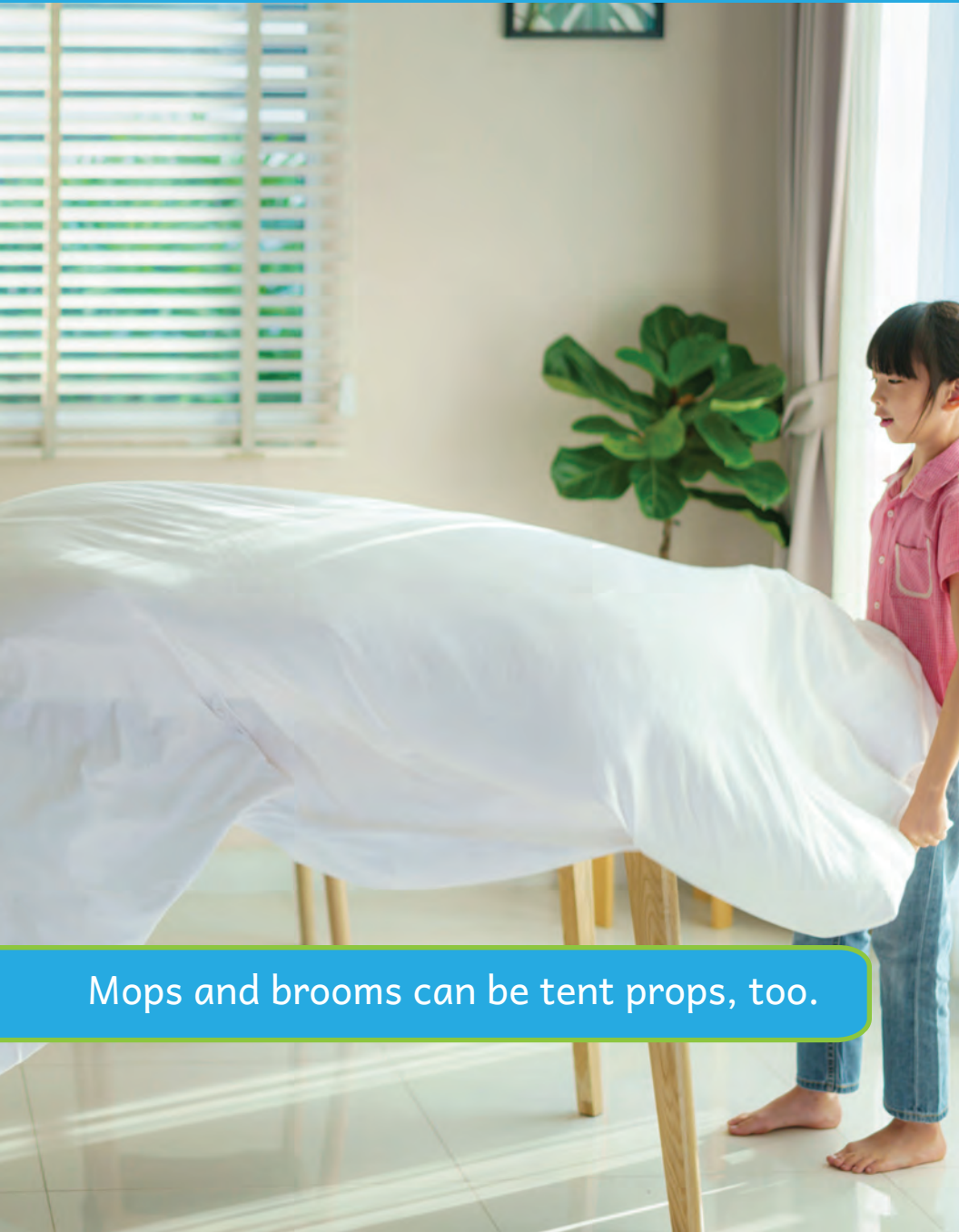
You can put lights on your tent.
