Rain comes from water in clouds.

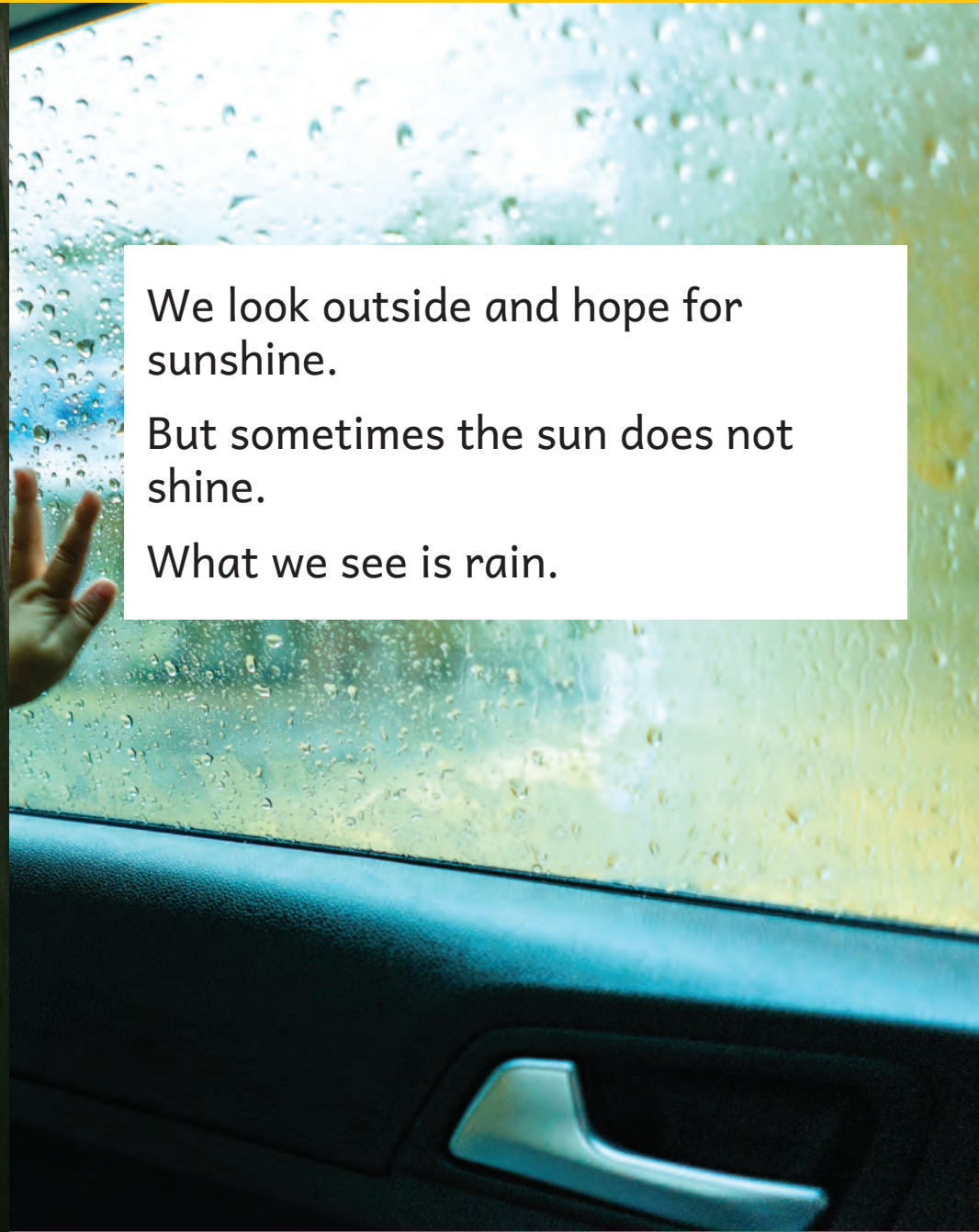
But we need rain.
