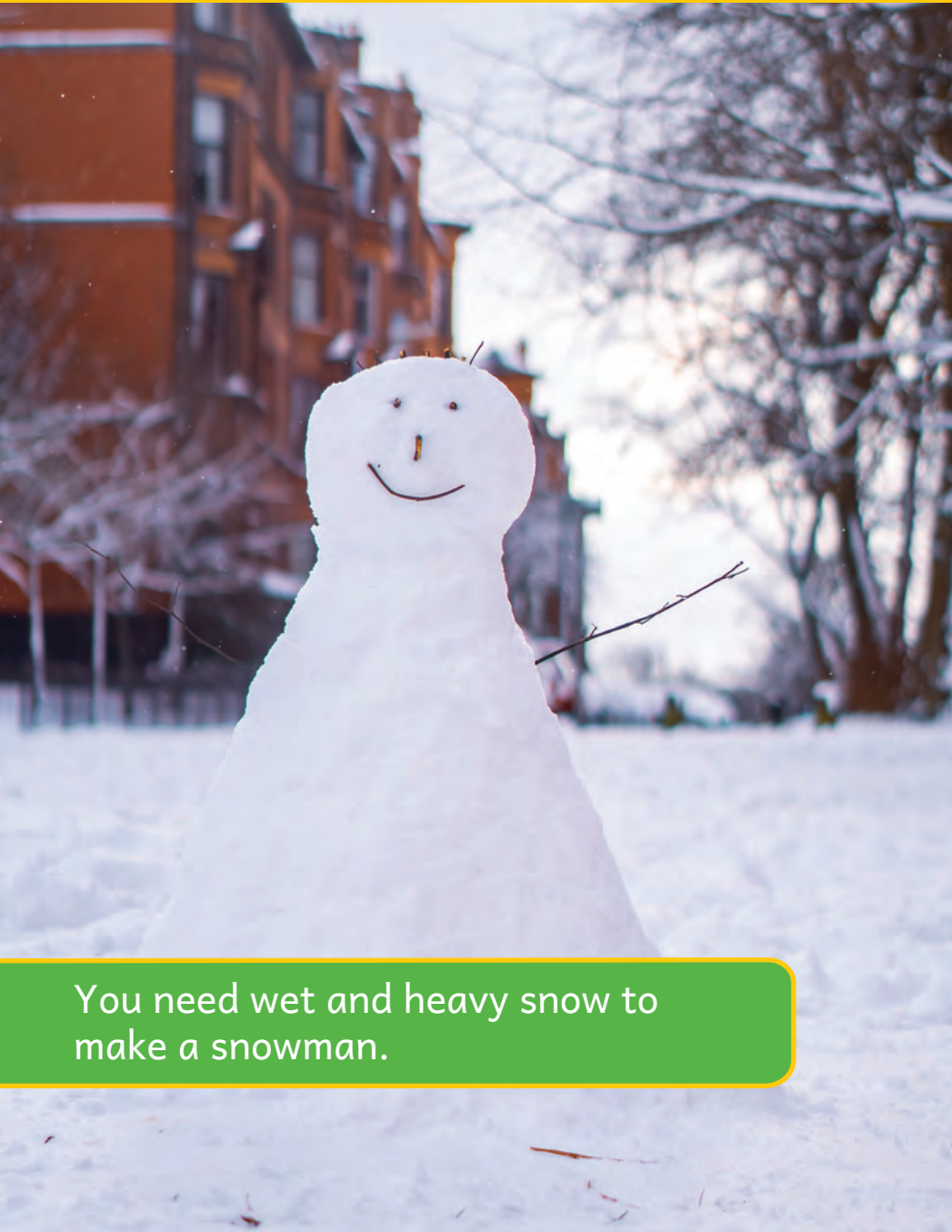


Snowflakes can fall so slowly that you can catch them on your tongue!
