

(croc·o·dile)



Definition: Unusually large, great or

strong; gigantic; huge

Example: Every year there is a *giant* pumpkin contest to see who can grow

the largest pumpkin.

(gi·raffe)





Mouth (mouth)



(os·trich)





Definition: of or pertaining to salt water; inhabiting salt water

Example: Many fish can only live in saltwater.

(ton)

Definition: A unit for measuring weight, equals to 2,000 pounds

Example: Beluga whales may be one of the smaller whales, but they can still weigh more than a ton.
