minor

less important than other things (adj)

a person under 18 years old (n) Those interviewed described additional waste: scarred vegetables abandoned in the field to save farmers the expense of harvesting them, or left to rot in a warehouse because of **minor** flaws.

So, they demanded that stores stop selling these offensive albums to **minors**. 
