(shoot·ing stars)

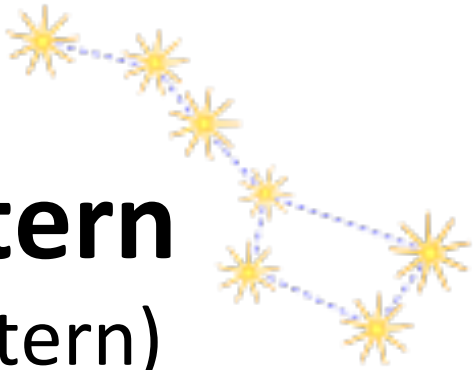


## Falling

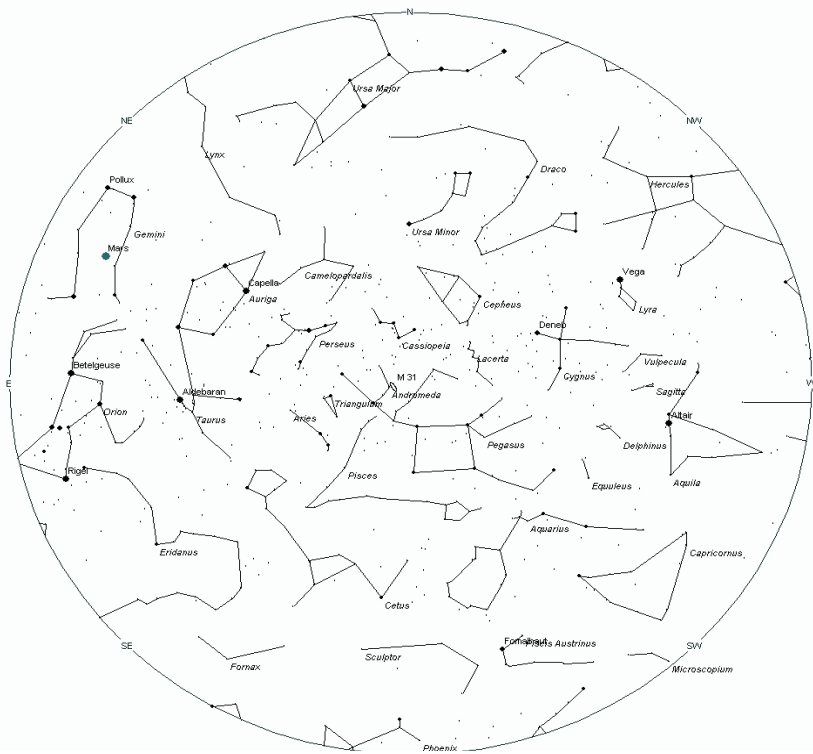
(fall·ing)

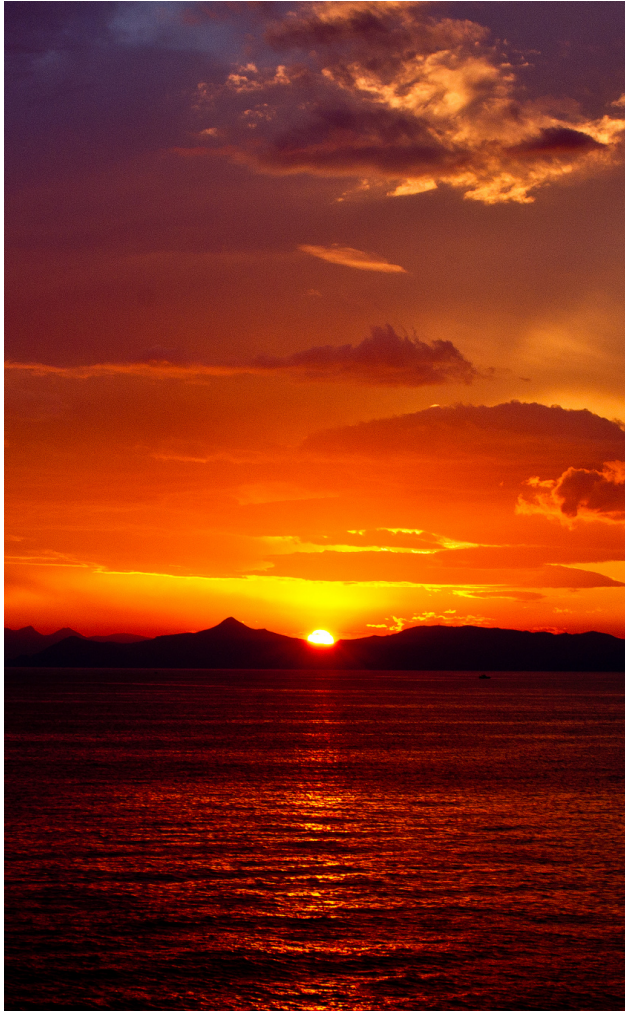
