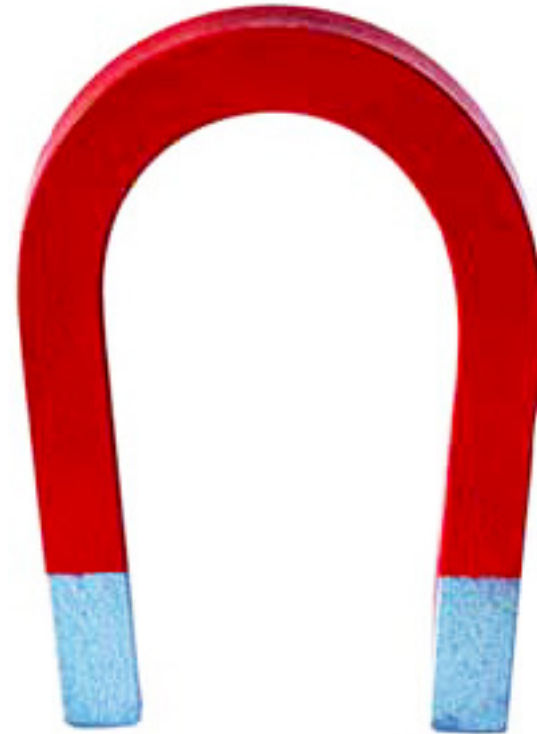

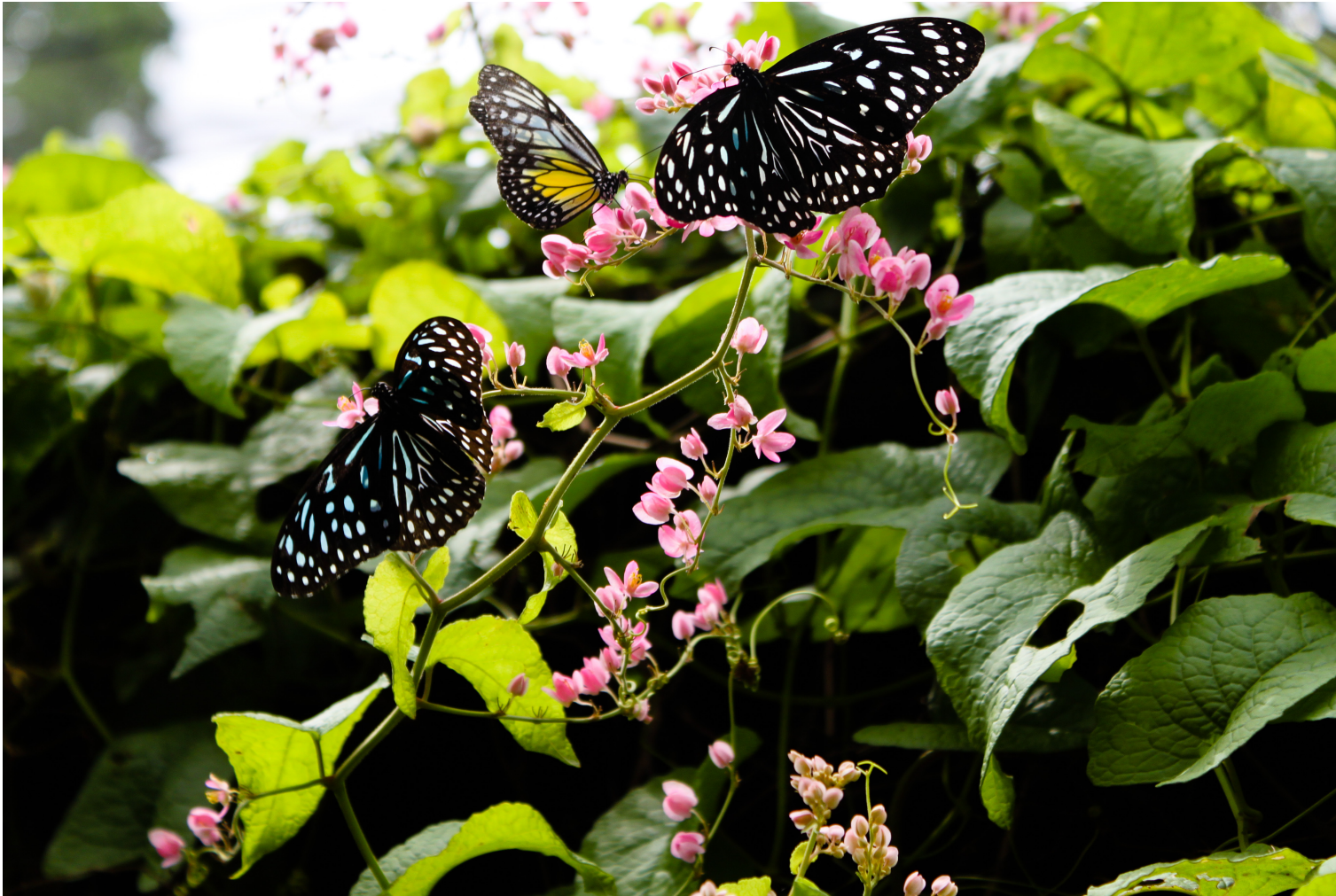

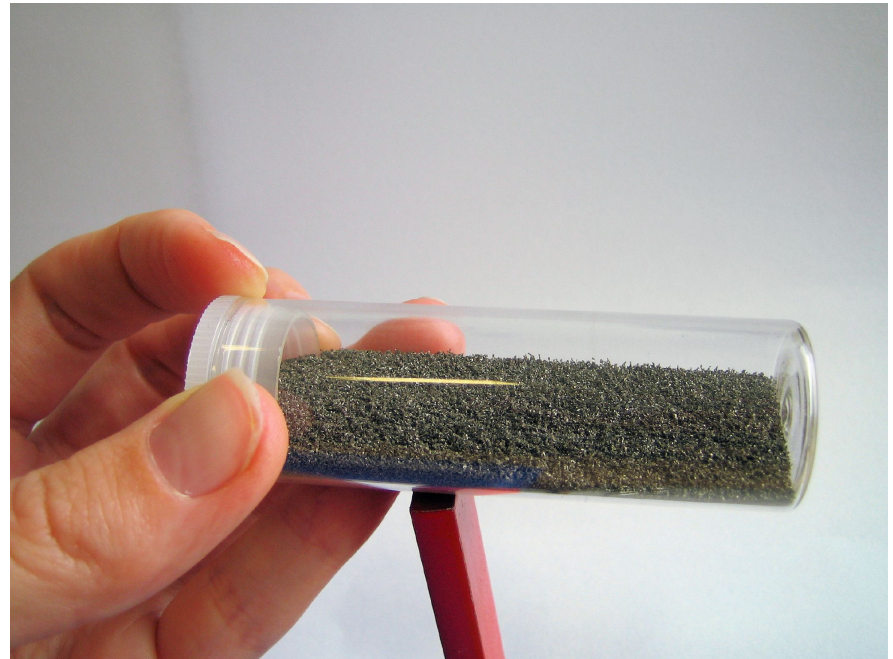


Needle
(nee·dle)

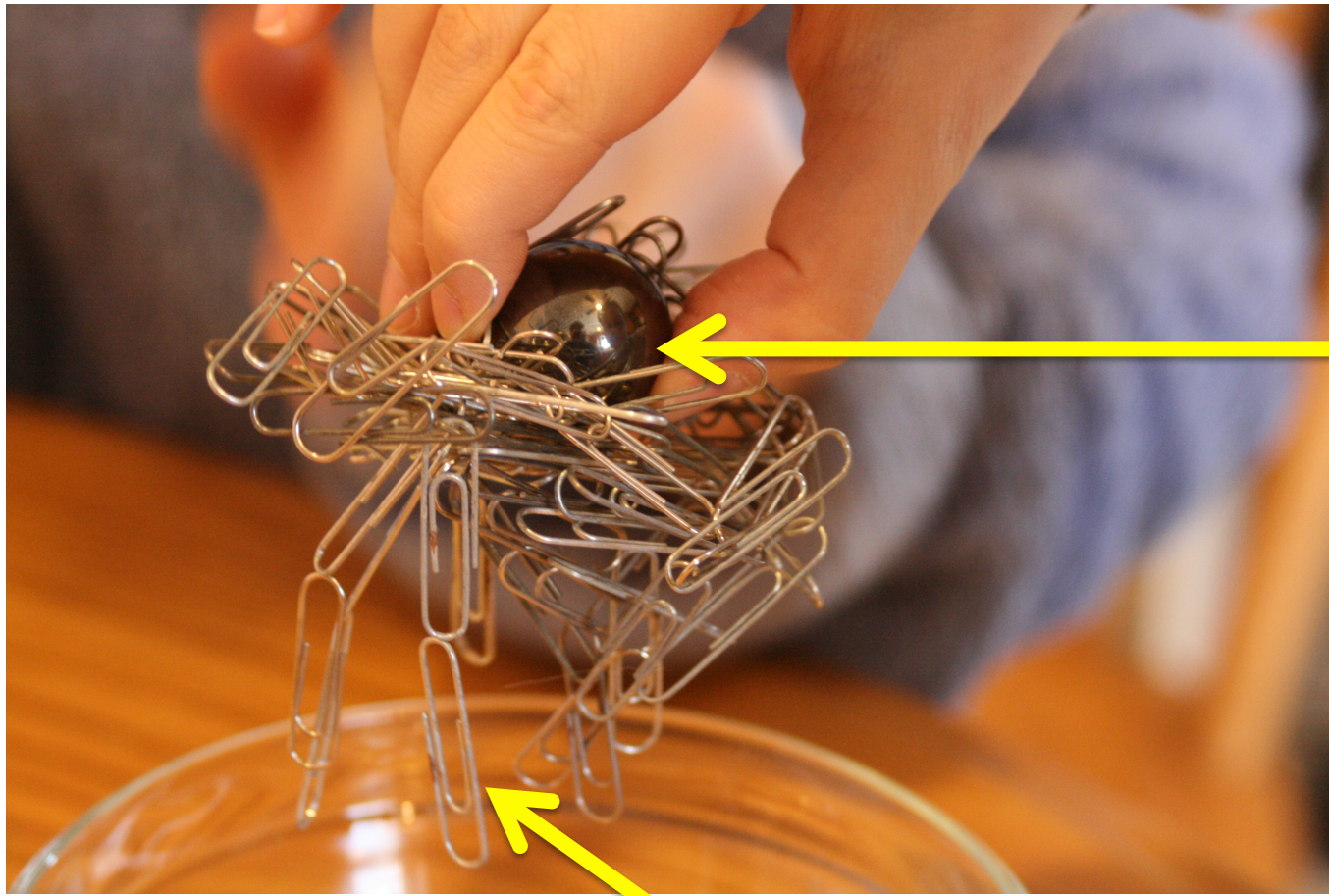
Center
