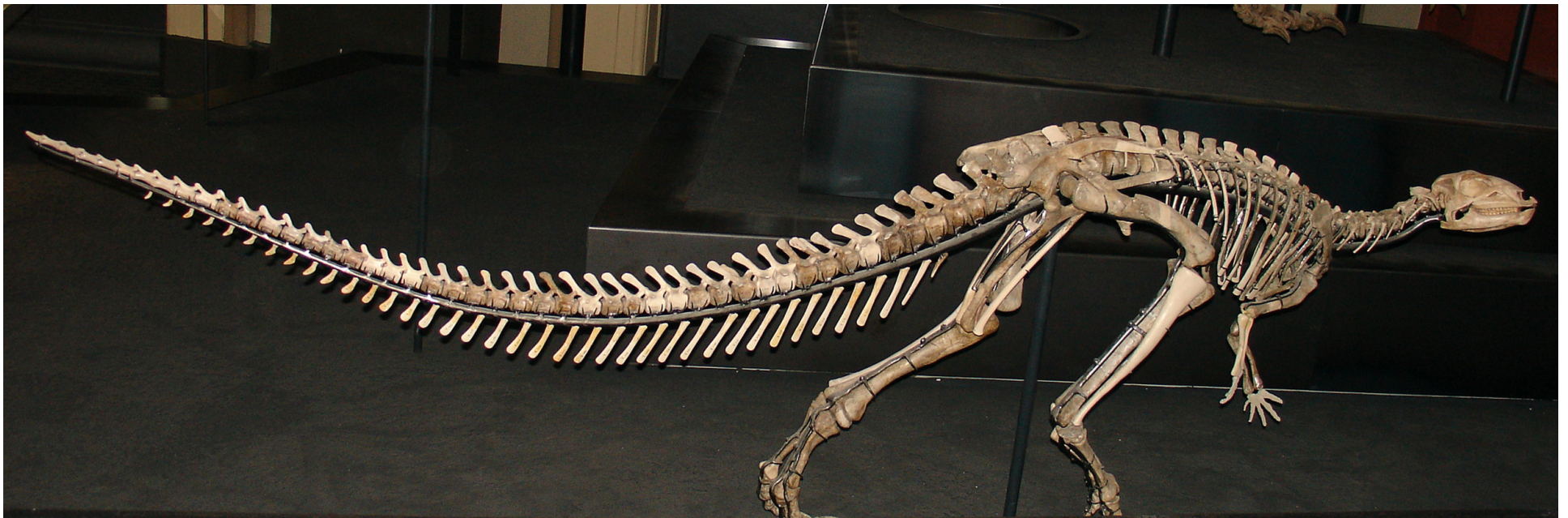

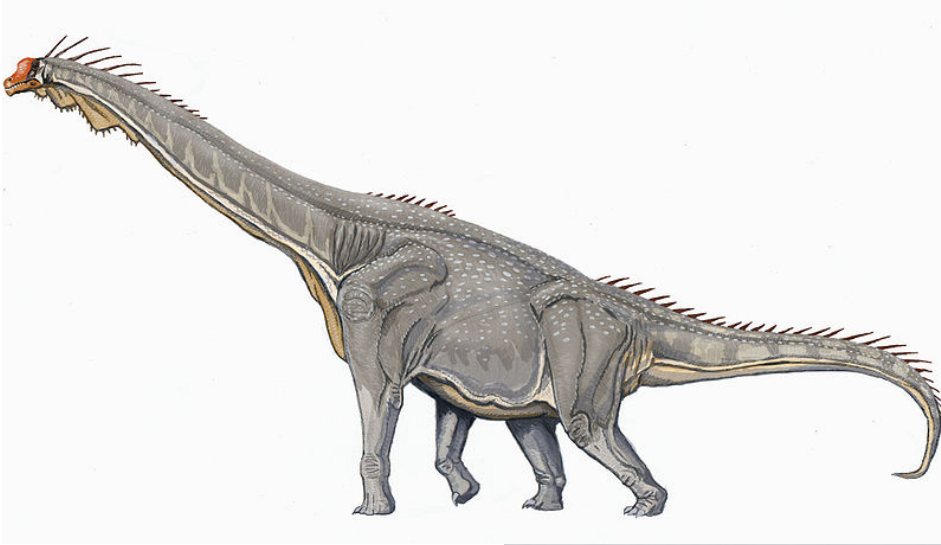

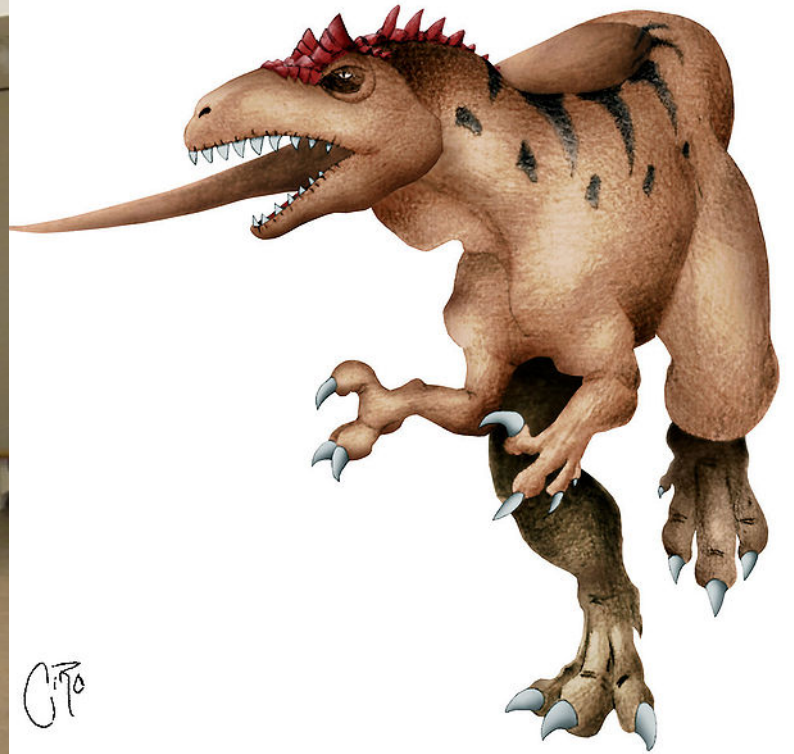

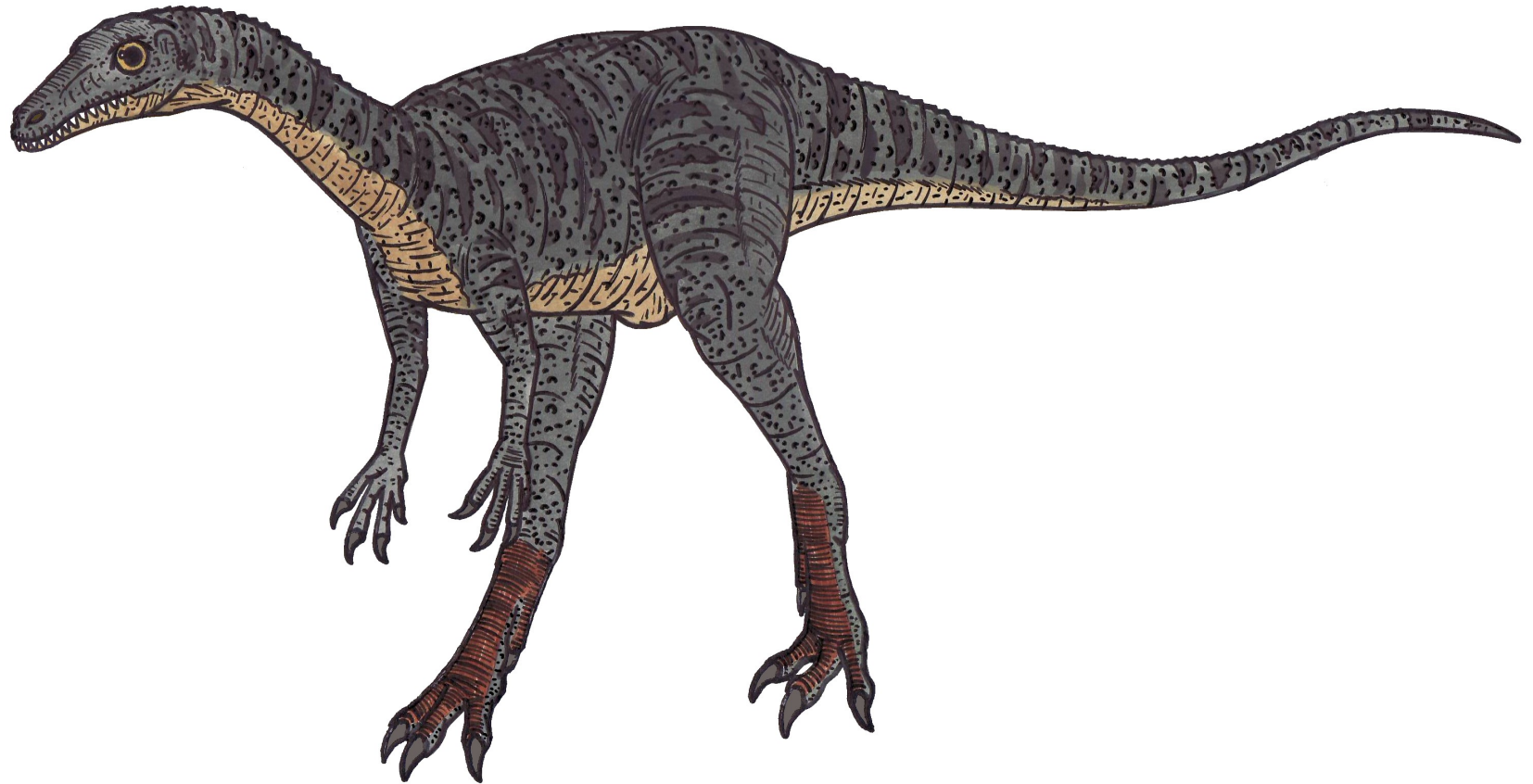


Illustration: A guesswork of how the late triassic reptile *Saltopus* ("Leaping foot"). Released into public domain by Conty in en:wikipedia.
