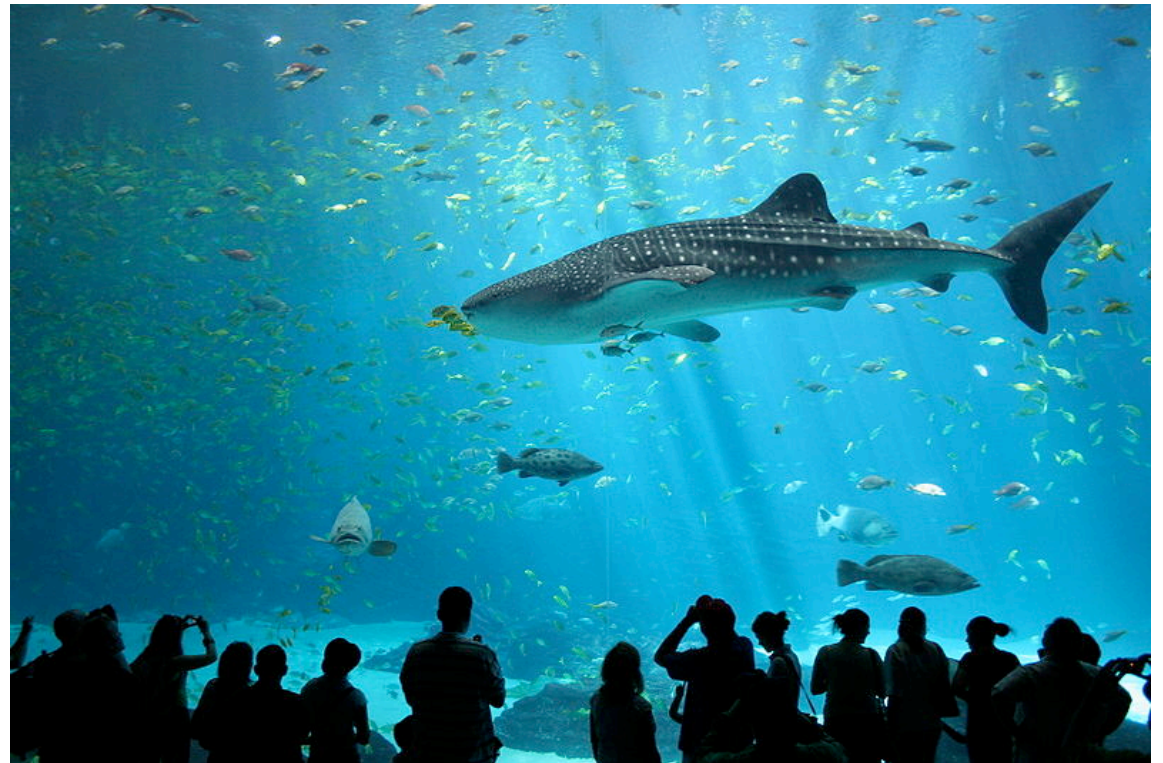

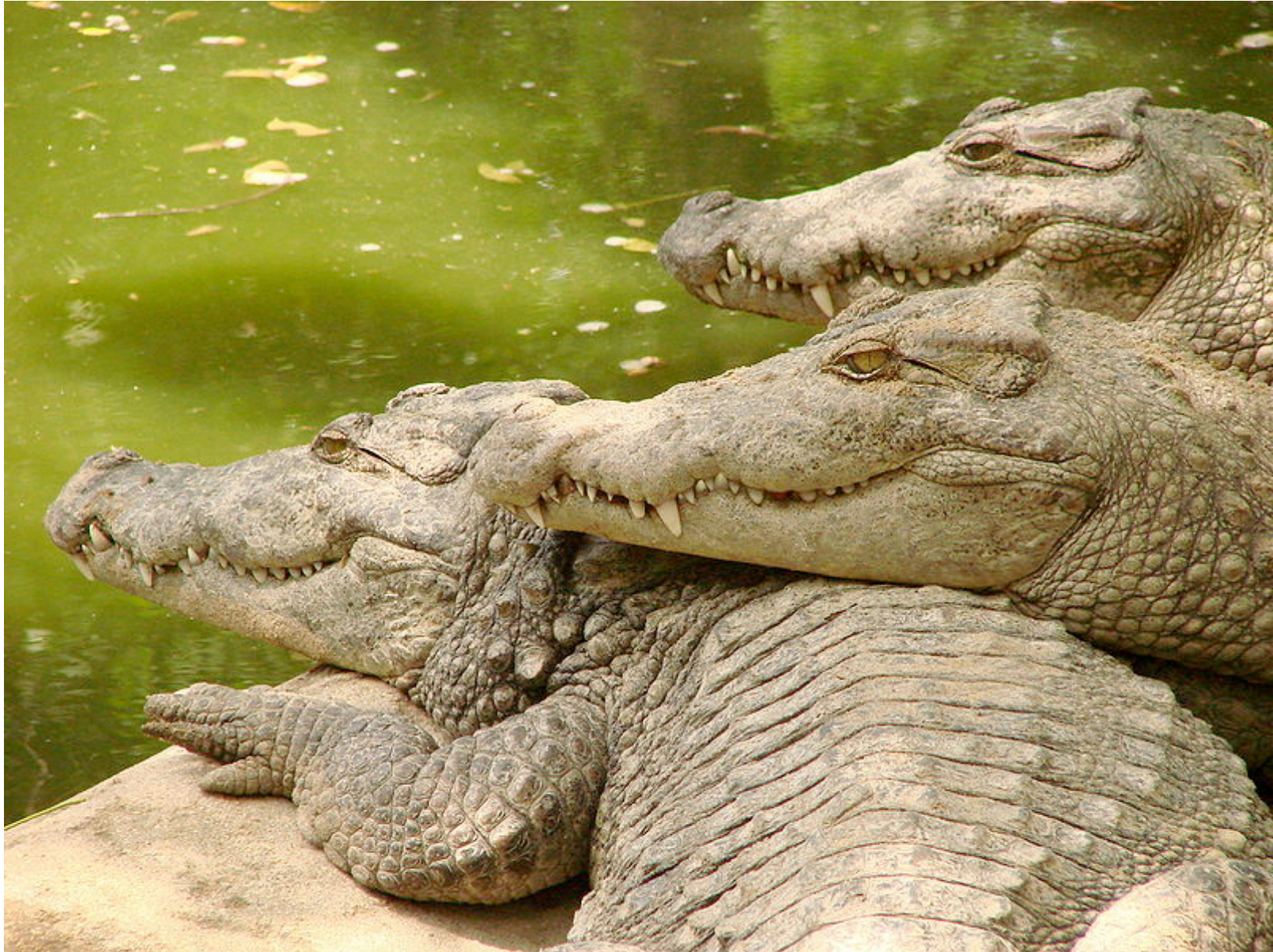

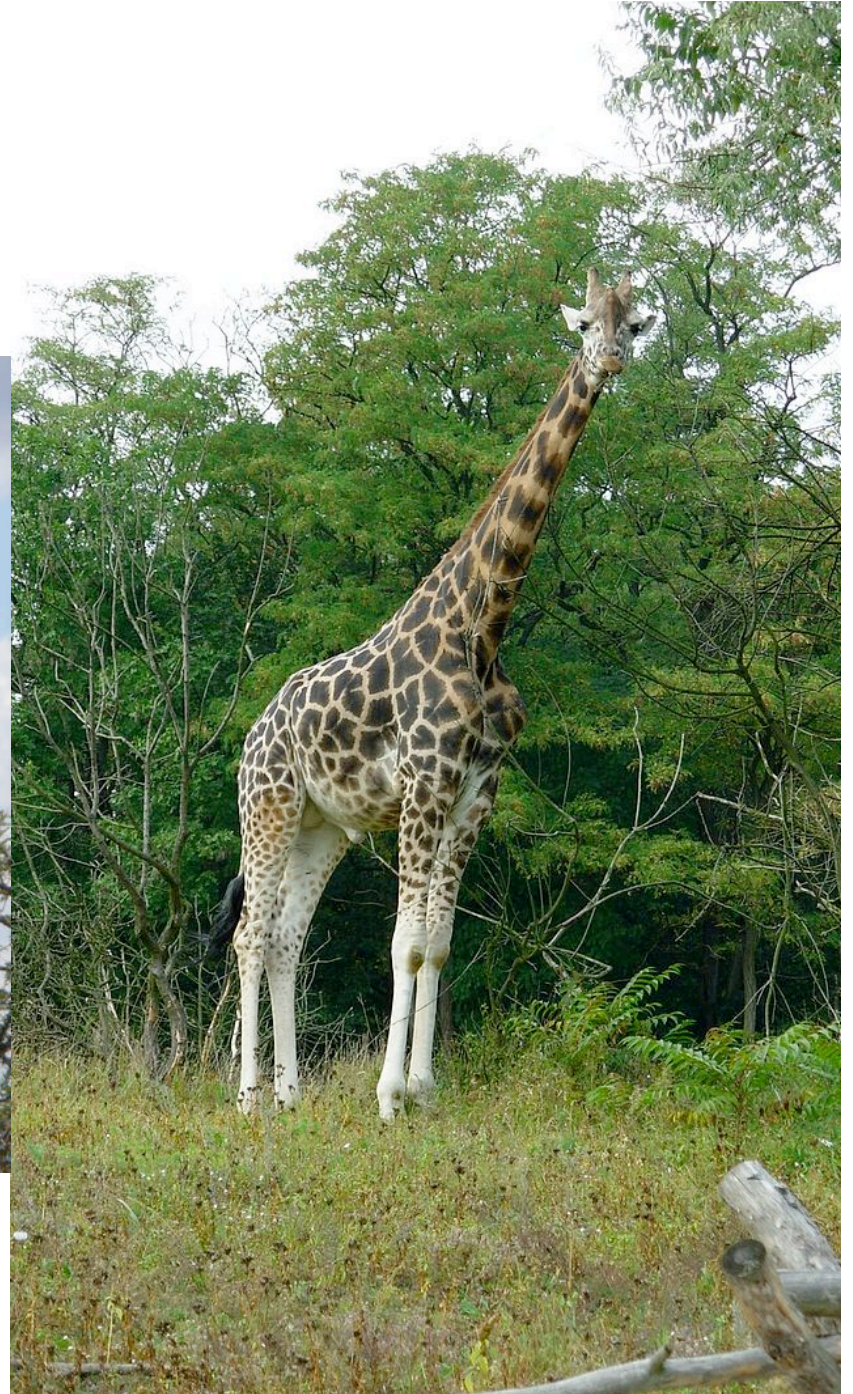

# Ostrich

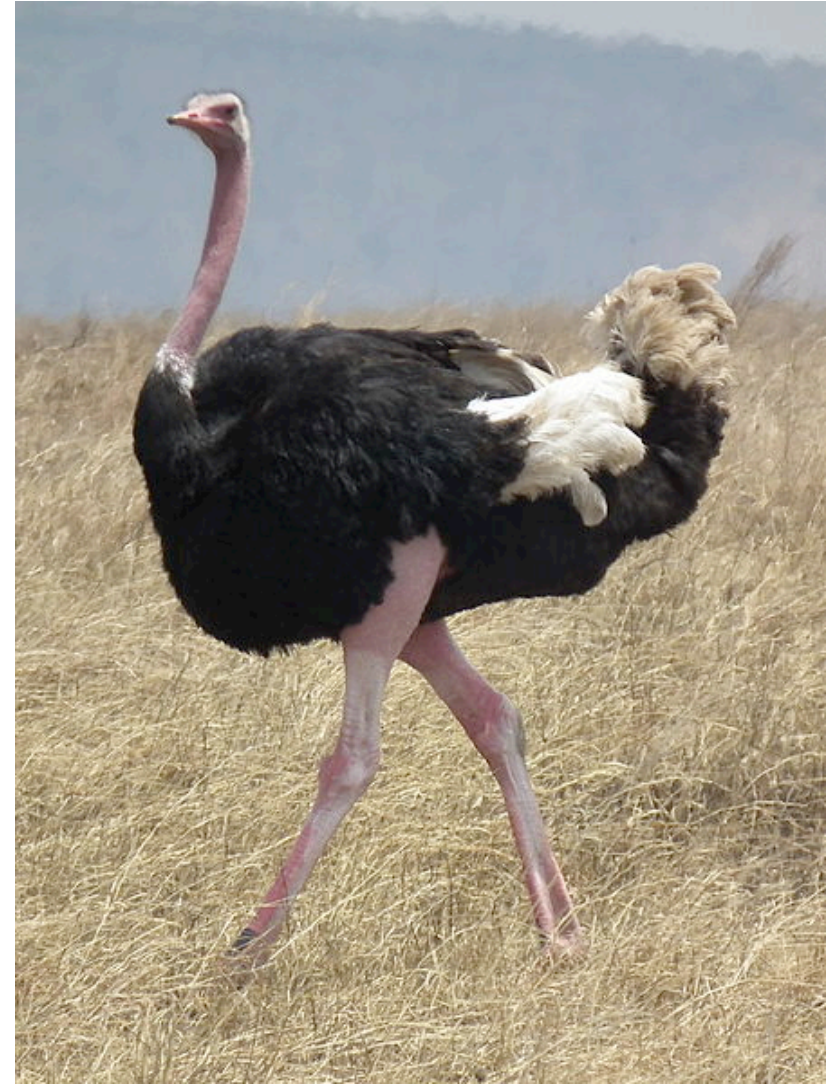

# Tons

- A unit for measuring weight, equals to 2,000 pounds
- Example: Beluga whales may be one of the smaller whales, but they can still weigh more than a *ton*.

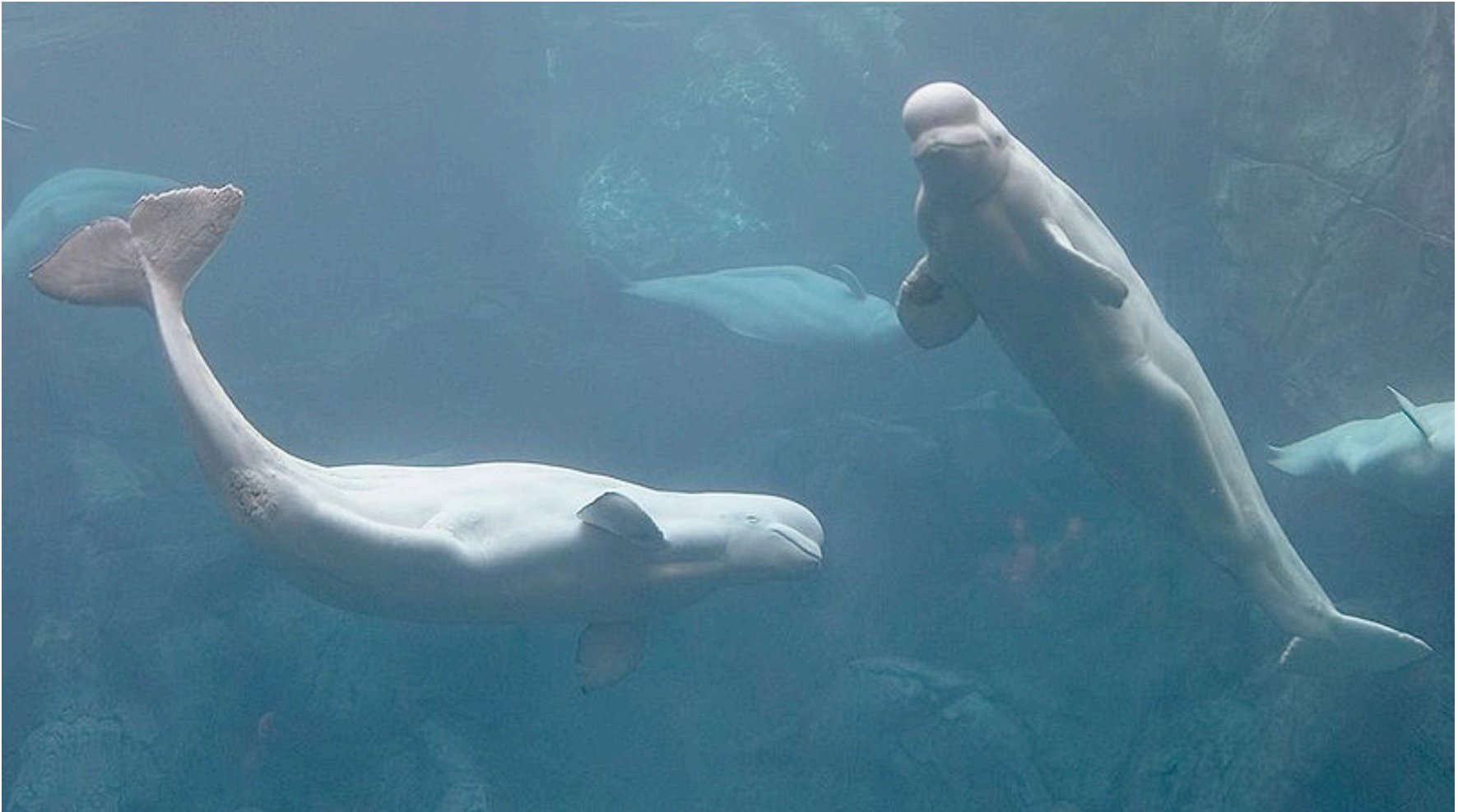
